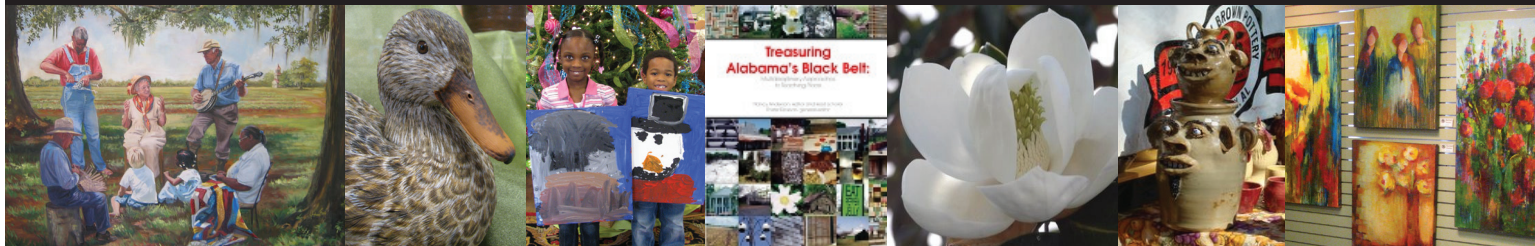


Treasuring Alabama's Black Belt: Field Trip and Day of Learning for Teachers

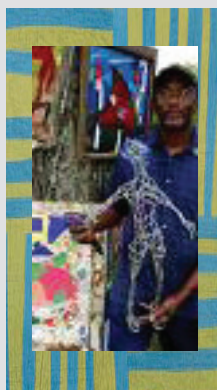

Treasuring Alabama's Black Belt: Multidisciplinary Approaches to Teaching Place is a curriculum guide about teaching the concept of place. Co-edited by Auburn University at Montgomery professor Nancy Anderson and Booker T. Washington Magnet High School creative writing teacher Foster Dickson, the 168-page book includes sections on social studies, English/language arts, and art. Each section includes a scholarly introduction, abstracts of suggested teaching materials, and lesson plans that could fit any educator's needs.

Treasuring Alabama's Black Belt offers teachers inside and outside Alabama not only the opportunity to take an in-depth look at this almost mythic region of the South, but also to have a curriculum that could be easily adapted to focus on other regions of the country.
